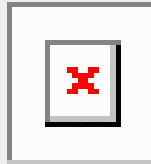

CARRIAGE OF 406MHZ EMERGENCY LOCATOR TRANSMITTER (ELTs)**1 NOTICE**

1. By 1 January 2008 in the Lilongwe FIR, all aircraft required to carry Emergency Locator Transmitters (ELTs) in accordance with Annex 6, should carry automatic ELTs operating on 406MHZ, and on 121.5MHZ for homing, in compliance with Annex 10 Volume 111 provisions.
2. 406MHZ ELTs installed on Malawi registered aircraft shall be registered with the Airworthiness Division of Department of Civil Aviation at the address given in paragraph 4
3. The following information shall be submitted for registration of ELTs:
 - a. Transmitter identification
 - b. Transmitter manufacturer, model and manufacturer's serial number
 - c. COSPAS-SARSAT Type approval number
 - d. Name, address (Postal and email) and telephone number of the owner and operator
 - e. Name, address (Postal and e-mail) and telephone number of other emergency contacts to whom the owner or operator is known
 - f. Aircraft manufacturer and type
 - g. Colours of the aircraft
 - h. Aircraft registration marks
 - i. 24-bit aircraft address, where appropriate
 - j. Last date of register
 - k. Battery expiry date
 - l. Place of ELT in the aircraft
