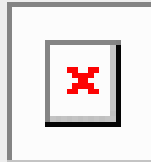

LIMITATIONS OF PILOT LICENCE HOLDERS WHO HAVE ATTAINED THEIR 60TH BIRTHDAY AND CURTAILMENT OF PRIVILEGES OF PILOT AGED 65 YEARS OLD

Pursuant to Article 38 to the Convention on International Civil Aviation, the Malawi Department of Civil Aviation has not filed a difference to International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO), with regard to the International Standards and Recommended Practises (SARPS), outlined in paragraph 2.1.10 of Annex 1 to the Convention on International Civil Aviation, Personnel Licensing.

In view of the foregoing, the Malawi Department of Civil Aviation shall not permit holders of a pilots' licence, which has been issued under its authority, to be engaged in scheduled or non – scheduled international commercial air transport operations:

- a. On reaching the age of 60 to act as Pilot – In – Command except as a member of multi-pilot crew and provided that not more than one pilot in multi – pilot crew has reached the age of 60.
- b. On reaching the age of 65 to act as pilot. This circular is issued for information, guidance and necessary action.
